## St. Peter & St. Paul

Today the City of Gloucester becomes a family celebrating the Feast of St. Peter and St. Paul. To St. Peter, the first Pope was given the keys to symbolize his authority; while St. Paul carries a sword, the symbol of his death. These two saints are the foundation stones of the Roman Catholic Church.

Gloucester's fishing community especially honors St. Peter because he was a simple Galilean fisherman. He is linked to St. Paul because together they spread the Gospel of Jesus. Both were martyred because of their faith in Jesus.

As I reflected on them the thought came to me that perhaps they were in a way involved in team ministry much after the fashion of Fr. Harrison and myself. St. Peter was older and very impetuous, speaking before fully thinking things through, while St. Paul was younger and more methodical. Different as they were, they were united as one though their faith in Jesus and the task to spread the Gospel.

As we forge ahead in our mission to unite the Catholic Community of Gloucester and Rockport, we strive with our differences in personality and styles of ministry to work with each other in our common mission of teaching the truth and serving our people in the important moments of their lives from birth to death, while attempting to model the love of Jesus.

Saints Peter and Paul serve as models. They showed their humanness, made mistakes, asked forgiveness and continued their mission up to their deaths out of love for Jesus. On this Feast Day we pray for those who sail and work on the sea, Cardinal Sean on his 64<sup>th</sup> birthday, and for the grace of wisdom and their spirit as we serve as Pastors of Holy Family Parish
