I also watched as thousands of people poured into churches hours later, desperately searching for answers from God as to how such a thing could happen in our country. They were begging God to let their loved ones rise from the rubble alive. It was God that they turned to.

This year St. Ann School is welcoming sixty new families. As I was interviewing them they were clear about a desire for their children to know God and to be educated in the Catholic faith. I was so impressed by their sincerity and was filled with hope for the future of our Church. It is God they are turning to.

I want to take this opportunity to thank my own family for imbedding the Catholic faith in me. Thanks to Sisters of St. Joseph and the Immaculate Heart of Mary Sisters who taught me about our rich traditions and love of God and neighbor and to encourage all of you readers to pass your faith on to a child, a friend, a stranger. Teach just one other today to turn to God.

**Here is how it works:** You authorize a specified amount of money to be electronically transferred directly from your checking, savings or credit card account to the parish.

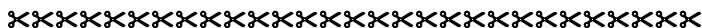
