## Retreat for HFP Missionaries ~ Past, Present and Future

In August, our parish mission committee will host two of the sisters we work with in Cevicos as well as the pastor of the parish there. One of the main events during their visit will be a one-day retreat at Eastern Point Retreat House which will take place on Saturday, August 14th from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. and will include a light continental breakfast and lunch.

This day of prayer, sharing and recollection will include brief talks by Sor Augustina, Sor Julia and Padre Michel on the topic of Catholic mission work. They will share with us some of the orientation materials used in Puerto Rico for missionaries preparing for Catholic mission work. Several members of our mission team will also share their faith experiences and review the objectives of the Holy Family Mission. There will be ample opportunity for anyone who wishes to share their personal experiences of how the mission has impacted their lives. There will be plenty of time to relax and or devote to quiet contemplation on the beautiful retreat grounds and many chapels in the Retreat House. The day will close with a mass offered by Padre Michel in the main chapel.

We are hopeful that this opportunity to pray together will serve to further connect our mission work with the teachings of Christ and the Church and help to assure that all of our generous efforts are united with and guided by the Holy Spirit.
