One of the main events during their visit will be a one-day retreat at Eastern Point Retreat House which will take place on Saturday, August 14th from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. and will include a light continental breakfast and lunch.

Solicit and review bids and quotes and negotiate contracts. Supervise any major construction, improvement or repair. Assist in the preparation of parish mailings and weekly communications.
