Reflections by Father Bullock

Prior to his passing, Father Bullock transcribed his reflections for inclusion in our parish bulletin. We will continue to share them with you in the coming weeks.

An example can be made of the American Express card commercial on T.V. A voice states, "You may not recognize me..." and then the signature on the card flashes across the screen (the idea being that the selling point of the card is its instantaneous recognition factor).

Had they existed at the time, Christ certainly would not have needed an American Express card. People may not have understood the deep meaning and symbolism of John's "Behold the Lamb of God." They were not theologians and knew nothing of the terms person and nature – or Trinity. But they instinctively saw something special, something that made Jesus stand out, brought Him instant recognition. The Gospel tells us that Jesus has COMPASSION on the people, but there was something even deeper. People sensed that He "understood" them – that He knew where they were coming from, to use the modern term.



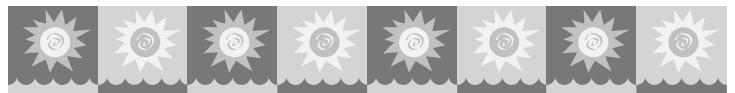
As those called to put on Christ, our spiritual American Express card of instant recognition can be the gift of understanding. It is a difficult gift – to be aware of where people are coming from – to be sensitive to the burdens they may be carrying. It is easy to remember where we are coming from – what is weighing upon us; it is not anywhere so easy to try to be alert to the troubled home life of a classmate, the secret worry of a neighbor, the heavy cross of a co-worker. But the effort to grow in such understanding is a sign of our continuing struggle to put on Christ more effectively, to increase our recognition as Christians.

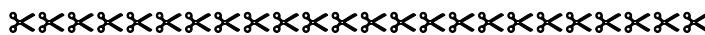
